Tuition Fee Schedule 2019/20

The tuition fees which will be charged by UCA for the 2019/20 academic year are shown on the following page. These should be read in conjunction with the notes below and the UCA Fee Regulations which can be found on our website.

Note 1

These fee rates are valid for the 2019/20 academic year only and are subject to increase in future academic years, including during continued registration. The fees stated for subsequent years of study do not serve as a guide as to what the fee level for that year of study might be in future academic years, as course fee structures change from time to time. Where fee adjustments are made year-on-year on-course to take account of inflation, this adjustment will be at or below the RPI-X forecast rate as advised by the independent Office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) and the Office for Students (OfS).

Note 1a

Fees regulated by the government are subject to changes in legislation and may change from time to time. This schedule will be updated as appropriate should changes in government policy lead to amended fee rates.

Note 2

For overseas students first registering in or after 2015/16: Overseas students progressing from an undergraduate course to a taught postgraduate course, or from a taught postgraduate course to a postgraduate research programme, may be eligible for a discount (scholarship) to reduce the fee of the first year of the course to which they are progressing. Students should refer to scholarship arrangements for the academic year into which they are progressing for details.

Note 2a

For overseas students first registering prior to 2015/16: With the exception of students first registering on the GDAD or a standalone pre-session English course, overseas students will pay, for the duration of uninterrupted studies (refer to the Fees Regulations for a full explanation of 'uninterrupted studies'), the fee rate in force in the year of first registration – these historical fee rates can be accessed on the University website. Therefore, the Overseas fee rates stated below apply to new entrants only. The fixed fee does not apply to students progressing to the MBA. Overseas students progressing directly from the GDAD course at UCA to a UCA Master's degree course will be entitled to a tuition fee discount of £1,000 in respect of the first year of that Masters course. This will be subtracted from the standard listed fee at the time of enrolment. To be eligible for this discount, students must enrol on the Masters course in the academic year immediately following completion of their international pathway course. There is no discount for students progressing from a stand-alone pre-session English course.

Note 2b

Overseas students who are new to the University for the Creative and not progressing from a previous course at UCA are eligible for a 4% discount off the full-price tuition fee for the first year of their course providing fees are paid in full prior to enrolment. The 4% discount cannot be combined with any other fee discount or scholarship. The early-payment discount does not apply to standalone pre-session English courses.

Note 3

We do not quote part-time overseas fee rates as overseas students may normally only obtain a student visa for full-time study. Where exceptionally we permit an overseas student to study in part-time mode the Registrar will determine an appropriate fee, based on the pro rata full-time fee rate.

Note 4

For including a pre-session English component, we charge an additional tuition fee as follows: £1,900 for the five-week course, £3,800 for the 10-week course, and £5,700 for the 15-week course.

All amounts quoted are in pounds sterling (£).

^a Undergraduate students from the Channel Islands and Isle of Man first enrolling in or after 2012/13 will be liable to the same fee as Home/EU students.

^b The stated full-time BA/BSc (Hons) fee applies to all new entrants to Higher Education in or after 2012/13 who are not eligible for the 'old regulations' funding regime that was in place prior to 2012/13. This may include direct entrants to other years. Eligibility is determined by Government. The 'old regulations' fees for full-time Home/EU students are determined annually by Parliament and are known as the 'regulated fees'.

^c New direct entrants into year 2 (or later) of a three or four-year course pay the Yr 1 of 3 tuition fee in their first year at UCA and the corresponding inflated fee in subsequent years.

PART TIME

The UCA Common Credit Framework permits Part-Time students to choose their intensity of study, provided that the total credit value of units taken each year is between 25% and 50% of the standard annual credit value of the Full-Time course. Fees are therefore calculated on a 'per credit' basis and are quoted per 10 credits. The fees listed below show the charge for a 10 credit unit. Fees for units of other sizes will be charged pro rata.

Home/EU students required to retake units with attendance will be charged per credit taken, in accordance with the Part-Time fee rates. Overseas students required to retake with attendance will be charged pro rata of the full-time Overseas fee for their course.
