## Tuition Fee Schedule 2020/21

---

The tuition fees which will be charged by UCA for the 2020/21 academic year are shown on the following page. These should be read in conjunction with the notes below and the UCA Fee Regulations which can be found on our website.

Note 1: These fee rates are valid for the 2020/21 academic year only and are subject to increase in future academic years, including during continued registration. The fees stated for subsequent years of study do not serve as a guide as to what the fee level for that year of study might be in future academic years as course fee structures change from time to time. Where fee adjustments are made year-on-year on-course to take account of inflation, this adjustment will be at or below the RPI-X forecast rate as advised by the Office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) and the Office for Students (OfS).

Note 1a: Fees regulated by the government are subject to changes in legislation and may change from time to time. This schedule will be updated as relevant should changes in government policy lead to amended fee rates

Note 2: New or progressing students may be eligible for a scholarship (in the form of a tuition fee discount) to reduce the fee of the first year of their new or next course. Students should refer to scholarship arrangements for the academic year which they are joining for details.

Note 2a: We offer a discounted annual tuition fee rate to overseas students who pay the full year's tuition fees in one instalment. Overseas students are eligible for a 4% discount off the full-price tuition fee for the year providing fees are paid in full prior to enrolment. In some circumstances, the 4% discount may be combined with other fee discounts or scholarships (see Note 2 above). Where this is allowed, the 4% discount is taken from the already reduced tuition fee. The early-payment discount does not apply to standalone pre-sessional English courses.

Note 3: We do not quote part-time overseas fee rates as overseas students are normally only admitted to UCA for full-time study. Where exceptionally we do permit an overseas student to study in part-time mode the Director of Academic Services will determine an appropriate fee, based on the pro rata full-time fee rate.

Note 4: Direct-entry students joining a course other than in Year 0 or Year 1 pay the rate for new students, not the published continuing student rate.

Note 5: All amounts quoted are in pounds sterling (£).

Note 6: The fee status of EU students may be affected by UK Government Policy following the outcome of any negotiations regarding the UK's proposed exit from the European Union.
